Key Stage 2 Progress

In 2017 progress for pupils is calculated using their 2013 Key Stage One results in reading, writing and mathematics teacher assessments (when the 2017 Year 6 cohort were aged seven) and the 2017 Key Stage 2 results in the reading and mathematics tests (reported as scaled scores) and the writing teacher assessments.
