**School Crossing Patrol** The County Council is proposing to no longer fund a school crossing patrol service in a bid to help close a £35m shortfall in their budget next year. They are asking communities to step forward and take on the funding of as many patrols as possible from September 2019. Schools are not expected to fund or employ patrols directly but instead to seek community and local business support to fund the crossing patrol from September 2019 at a cost of £4,000 per person. Our Governors have written to our local MP, Jeremy Lefroy, expressing their concerns at the loss of the Crossing Patrol Service. If you also feel strongly about this matter could I urge you to do likewise?
