The governors of the school have confirmed that the school should encourage the wearing of its distinctive uniform. It is considered that this gives pupils a sense of belonging to their school community.

Please name all items of uniform. There is an expectation that pupils will be able to dress themselves in their uniform (support will be available for pupils with specific needs) All pupils are representing the school so should be appropriately dressed and well presented at all times.

Boys:

Black trousers/shorts

White shirt/polo shirt-Reception class only

School tie

'Burton Manor' logo sweatshirt

Black/grey socks

Black shoes/ankle boots-(Nov to Easter)

Girls:

Black skirt (knee length), trousers, shorts or pinafore dress

White shirt/polo shirt-Reception class only

School tie

'Burton Manor' logo sweatshirt or cardigan

Black/grey/white socks

Summer dress (school green, checked or striped)-Summer Term to Oct

Black shoes/boots (not fashion boots)-Nov to Easter

Due to health and safety issues sandals will not be permitted. Hair accessories should be in school colours (green or black)

PE Kit:

Pumps, preferably velcro (KS1) /trainers (KS2)

Black shorts

T-Shirt of your child's house/ team colour - *can be purchased from the school office*

Tracksuit/sweater top (preferably black/navy blue)

Tracksuit trousers (preferably black/navy blue)

Jewellery

For reasons of safety, the wearing of any jewellery other than watches and stud ear-rings is not allowed, unless worn for religious reasons.

Teachers will not remove pupils' stud ear-rings so they are not to be worn on PE days if pupils cannot take them out themselves. We strongly recommend that pupils who choose to have their ears pierced do so at the start of the summer holidays to avoid having to miss P.E or Swimming lessons during term time.
